MICRO-CREDENTIALS

Micro-credentials offer PSEA members competency-based recognitions issued for professional learning experiences. They provide a way for educators to develop skills and acquire knowledge to improve classroom practice and support student success.

COLLEGE CREDIT OR ACT 48

Each micro-credential can earn a member up to 20 Act 48 hours. In lieu of the 20 Act 48 hours, members attaining a micro-credential have the option of obtaining 1 college credit (equivalent to 30 Act 48 hours) from PennWest Edinboro University for a fee of \$70 per credit.
