

High School Competition Details

2025 Educators Rising PA State Conference

The 2025 competition categories are listed below, with the guidelines and rubrics in each link. Students **DO NOT** need to submit an online application for the state conference on the National Competition page. If a student competed at the previous conference(s), they are allowed to compete in the same competition(s) at state and national conferences.

All competitions are open to high school students, 9th-12th grades, who are <u>current</u> <u>Educators Rising members</u>.

Individual Competitions

- <u>Creative Lecture (TED Talk)</u> Students must use the <u>2025 prompt</u>; Individual only event; open to spectators (<u>Speeches will not be pre-scored and do not need to be</u> <u>submitted before competitions</u>).
- Educators Rising Moment speech must follow the competition guidelines; Individual event, open to spectators (<u>Speeches will not be pre-scored and do not need to be</u> <u>submitted before competitions</u>).

Team Competition

- 1. <u>Public Service Announcement-Teacher Recruitment</u> must follow the competition guidelines; closed to spectators.
 - Only teams of 2-4 students can compete in this event (minimum of 2 students)
 - All students will work equally on the public service announcement

Educators Rising members who plan to compete at the state conference must register for the competition of their choice by *Friday, March 7, 2025.*

*The top 10 places per competition will be eligible to compete at the Educators Rising National Conference (<u>up to two students per school in each individual event per division</u> <u>and one team for team events per division</u>). Funding is not included in the award nor provided for students/chapters.

*Students can attend the National Conference with a parent. Parents must register for the conference if they plan to attend, including the awards ceremony. Parents are not permitted to watch their students compete unless they are competing in a public competition. Teacher leaders are not obligated to attend if a parent attends with their student.
