Associate UniServ Representative

In the summer of 2025, PSEA will hire THREE full-time, limited term labor representative positions in Pittsburgh, Mechanicsburg and Wilkes-Barre.

The Associate UniServ Representative ("AUR") position is a temporary, limited term position existing for training and developmental purposes. The goal of the AUR position is to enhance the skills and competence level of the incumbent to enable the successful completion of the full-time UniServ selection process (after one year) in order to be eligible to apply for future permanent labor representative positions with PSEA. The AUR will initially be exposed to intensive training and job shadowing opportunities with PSEA staff. As the AUR gains experience and competence within their role, the supervisor may assign the individual increasingly challenging work opportunities.

These positions will provide assistance to labor relations staff who represent members and local associations, providing comprehensive support in bargaining and defending the rights of members and local associations in all areas of employment. Staff are also engaged in organizing, community relations, legislative/

political activity, school reform activity, delivery of training, and strategic planning in their assigned service areas.

Applicants should have an interest in labor and education, and possess strong research, interpersonal, problem-solving and writing skills. Successful applicants must analyze complex issues, research and apply appropriate contract language, legal and policy provisions and prepare

Resume documents related to the assignment. Selfsupporting computer skills are essential to this role.

PSEA is looking for candidates willing to make an initial commitment of one to two years. These positions, available in the summer of 2025, include a salary of approximately \$86,000 and a comprehensive benefits package. A minimum Bachelor's degree is required for consideration.
